Current Active Projects:

High Strength Nickel Plated Wire Testing

This testing is being performed at the request of SAE by contact manufacturer members of EIA. The objective of this testing is to investigate the reported problems of high contact resistance values associated with high strength nickel plated wire and the use of existing contact crimp tooling and existing Mil-C-39029 contacts.

Status Report:

Testing is completed by 3 of the original 4 members that had committed to perform tests. One manufacturer has since withdrawn from performing testing do to test time constants. The three manufacturers that have completed their testing are in the process of summarizing their results and hope to have preliminary summary at next months SAE meeting. At the next EIA meeting, I will supply the data from our testing.
